Welcome to the March edition of Street Jesus e news. Our news is crammed full of events this month I think the most we have ever published. It is usually busy in the run up to Easter but maybe the reason also is that the local Christian community whilst being just as busy as ever communicates more effectively and with social media we become more aware of the great things that are going on. So please scroll down and see if there is anything that might just help to

strengthen you faith. We had our first outreach of the year at Yoxford village hall in February and were able to raise awareness of the Beehive project and many visitors to our stall seem to have some link to, or direct experience of poverty in Africa. Again we had objections to giving to big overseas charities but after explaining to one gentleman that with a micro project like the Beehive every penny



goes direct to where it is needed with no large admin and no siphoning funds through corrupt government agencies. He actually ended up donating some money. This is part of what Street Jesus is about shifting attitudes toward compassion and understanding rather than having hard hearts.

Our outreach to Leiston coop had to be cancelled at the last minute as Evangelina developed a puncture, to say we were deflated was an understatement as we had been so looking forward to it. We too can become spiritually deflated and in need of a boost. In our Church we have been doing a series on anger. We can get very angry about injustice and when i think too much about how the girls have been treated prior to being cared for at the Beehive i can feel that way too but it is good in that it motivates us. Often people get angry over ideas and we sometimes experience this on the Street when people do not like the idea of Christianity. but if we are honest the most heart felt anger is often in our personal relationships when we either disappoint or others disappoint us. These are always a result of the



imperfect people we are. We have to somehow remove the nail, mend and re-inflate the tyre so that we may become spiritually pumped up and once again roadworthy to travel on Gods road.

This coming Saturday 3rd we will be at Rendlesham Bentwaters Old Jet monthly market which is held on the old airfield site, this will be a new venue for us so we are very much

looking forward to our visit there. We will not be collecting for the

Beehive on that day but will be supporting their own charity Suffolk Accident Rescue Service. Proceeds from the sale of African crafts though will go to the Beehive as usual.

It is with eager anticipation then that we look toward to Easter to both reflect and celebrate. On Good Friday we will be taking part in the march of witness in Wickham Market which is an annual event and was very well attended last year. Evangelina the Street Jesus van takes part in the procession, with



the vital message of LOVE-HOPE-FREEDOM-JUST AS YOU ARE.

On Easter Saturday we will be on the Triangle at the top of Hamilton



road in Felixstowe 10am -4pm. This is a venue we attended last year, On April 7th we will be holding our bi-annual yard sale here at Featherbroom gardens in Wickham Market. These have become increasingly popular and we hope yet again to be able to support the Beehive Kenya with vital resources and raise awareness of the Christian work there.

Looking further ahead to May we are planning some indoor craft markets including the late May bank holiday. In June we are booked for the Wickham Market fun day on the 2nd and Woodbridge regatta which will be held on Sunday 17th. As you can see we have plenty to look forward too and are very excited about the programme for the months ahead, We are now also being invited to do talks about our project in various churches. We will be speaking at Leiston St

Margarets on March 18th and Framlingham Baptist church on April 29th If anybody would like to join us in our outreach or you would like us to speak in your church then please contact us.

Our bible reading this month is from the book of Ezekiel which talks about Gods people being in exile in a foreign land just as we as Christians are exiles



in the world today. We too await to return more fully into Gods presence just as they wanted and were promised a return to the promised land but God also offers us a sanctuary even though we are still in exile. If we abandon the idols of the world he rewards us with a tender and responsive heart. The passage speaks of Gods will being done and that he wants us to be his people. What a lovely thought.

During Lent rather than deny myself something like chocolate I have tried instead to do something for somebody and some days I have been going up to the landfill site at Foxhall with Evangelina, it's a great place to evangelise as you help people carry their rubbish to put in the skips. I have had some good conversations there amongst the waste and I like to think Jesus being used to embracing those who were considered rubbish in society may also have been there. In fact Jesus spoke of Gehenna the place where rubbish was burned outside the city wall in Jerusalem as an analogy to hell. Does Jesus want to sort through the rubbish in your life? 




