Street Jesus News:

Welcome to the June edition of our Street Jesus newsletter. Having returned from spring harvest with great enthusiasm learning about how we can become Game Changers in our own communities, at work, at home and in Church we then went on to enjoy a wonderful weekend with our Church family here in Wickham Market as we took over Sizewell Hall for the weekend. Family was the operative word as we had people from all generations and a record number of youth which was very encouraging particularly as most had come from non Church going families. We also had a number of new families who had come to us through Messy Church and the monthly Café Church. It is often assumed that only older people attend Church and that its not a very cool thing for younger people to be doing but what we saw was a lot of fun being had. The youth did a sketch on David and Goliath for us with a modern twist which was very funny. On the Saturday evening we had a very Wacky quiz indeed which everyone was involved in which will live long in the memory. There were lots of tears of the laughter variety. This is what Jesus asks of us to be a real community where we can enjoy time together yet also support one another. It amazing how much better you get to know people in that setting even though you see one another most Sunday mornings. There are great opportunities to pray for and support one another. Our guest speakers were Simon and Kerry Morris from Burlington Road Baptist church, the teaching was very good and caused a real buzz of conversation in the break time as we were challenged to find new ways of going out into the community to share our faith. Much of what we do in Church is based around the attractional model of getting people into Church but we were introduced to the concept of Oikos which is a Greek word to describe different types of families and their functions. The concept involves each of us creating an extended family, not just our personal friends. This new family of love is for anybody regardless of whether they are Christians or not. Meals as in the early Church are central and often revolve around a shared activity. There is not enough room here to explain the concept fully but i am sure I could provide you with extra information should you be interested. All in all it was a great weekend. Many Churches use the facilities at Sizewell Hall and other places for such weekends and they are very strengthening for the body of Christ. On Pentecost Saturday I had the pleasure of joining the Presence team in Ipswich to offer prayer on the street to those who needed. There were opportunities to talk to people around the theme of "What would make your world a better place" We had some beautiful answers and also some funny ones my favourite being "a better Vodaphone signal would be nice" but in the main the replies illustrated the human need for love peace respect and security. Who better than Jesus to provide that. It was great to be out on the street again after a year out with illness, thank you guys for letting me join in.
