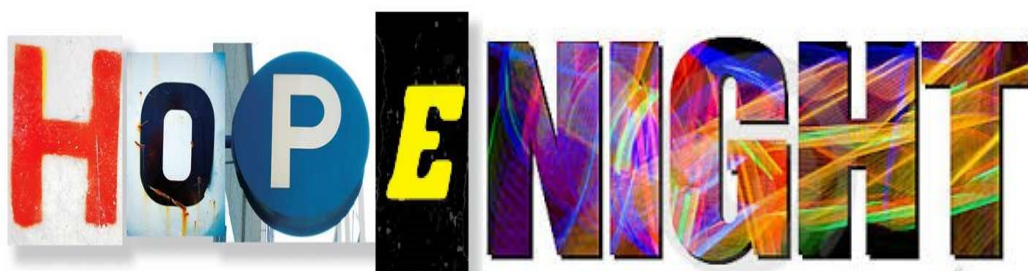

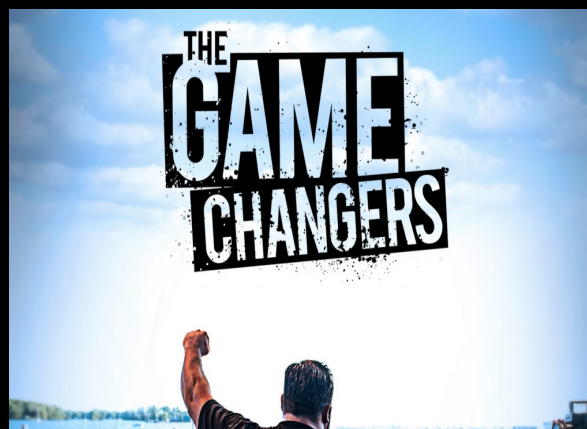

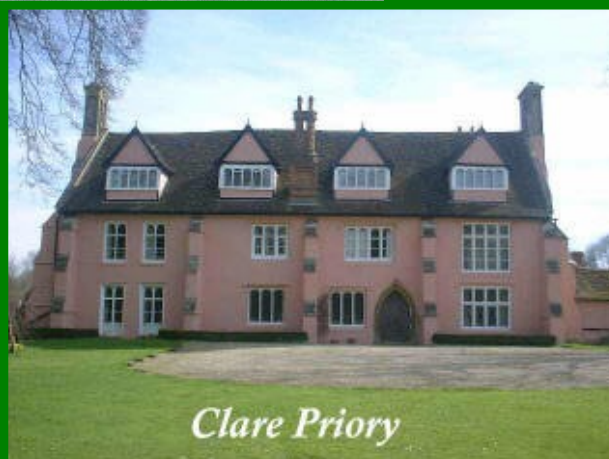

SMITH

Transformed life by Dave Smith is a forensic but well conveyed study on the book of Ephesians. The book asks what is our identity, belonging and purpose in life and how are these lived out in Christ. The book divides Ephesians into 50 days of readings with areas on which to reflect and respond and to which we can make a practical application each and every day. There are summary points at the end and a call to be challenged renewed and transformed by what we are reading. There are also other resources available which along with the book provides a good focus for home group study or a series of talks in your church.

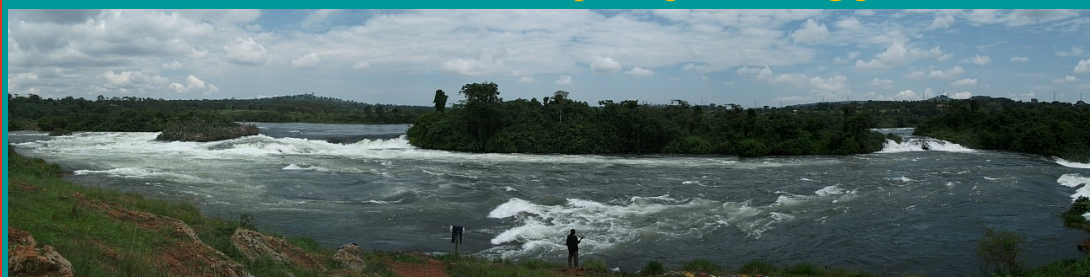
